Each year thousands of boys and girls strive to improve their skills and enjoyment of the great game of baseball. The South Shore Baseball Club Summer Camp provides a great opportunity to do just that. The SSBC camp will feature its usual excellent staff and facilities, assuring each camper a rewarding experience while enjoying our popular game.

Camp Director Frank Niles and his expert staff of qualified instructors will combine to make the SSBC camp a valuable and worthwhile experience for each camper.

Individual attention will be emphasized in all aspects of the game. Pitching, catching, defense, base running and hitting will all be featured in special sessions and lectures. The staff will be sure to devote special attention to any individual needs or areas of improvement that a camper may have.

All campers will be grouped according to age, ability, physical maturity and previous experience. The instruction will range from basic fundamentals to advanced skills. Each camper will play a minimum of one game per day.

The youngest level will be the Rookies. This half-day group, ages 5 to 7, will play with safety balls and feature fun-filled drills on all aspects of the game. Players will learn the basics of the game, including actual positions. The ball will be pitched to them! The SSBC does not believe in Rookies hitting off a tee.

Ages 8 to 10 will play in our AA level, ages 10 to 12 will compete in AAA, and kids 13 and older will be on the Big Diamond. All levels will be encouraged to concentrate, anticipate and communicate. Hustling on and off the field and playing with enthusiasm will be expected at all levels.

Camp will be held rain or shine. In case of inclement weather, we will move inside to the high school building.

Each week will provide its own pennant race, standings and mythical camp championship at each level. New teams are formed each Monday morning. Players can attend from one through all four weeks.

Other regular features of a SSBC camp include Rules Committees, Instant Cash Trivia, Mini Break-Out Clinics, Coaches Hitting Contest and Box Score Madness.
